With large subsea lifting capability and ample accommodation, this CSV is optimized to meet the growing demands of offshore wind, power cable, and offshore energy projects in APAC.

A Flexible Tool for Cable Installation and Repair, Subsea and Topside Operations

The VARD 3 39 CSV is a multi-role platform designed to perform a wide variety of tasks across the offshore project lifecycle. Its flexible configuration enables smooth transition between cable laying and repair, subsea construction, IMR (inspection, maintenance & repair), and topside support activities. The vessel's key features include:

- A large, unobstructed deck area with easily removeable bulwarks designed for multiple mission profiles
- State-of-the-art DP2 dynamic positioning for precise station-keeping during critical subsea operations, with triple redundant controllers
- A high-capacity offshore crane suitable for heavy lifts and complex construction activities paired with space for two work class ROVs in hangars
- An under-deck carousel of 2,500 MT that can be paired with our modular cable lay spread and ROVs for subsea cable installation scopes

These capabilities allow the vessel to serve as a cost-effective and efficient solution for developers and contractors executing complex offshore projects requiring a combination of cable, subsea, and topside works.
